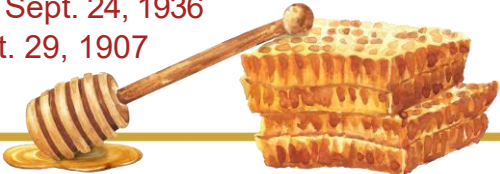
September Birthdays

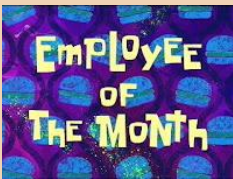
